Mr. Elston is a graduate of the University of Western Ontario and holds bachelor's degrees in arts and in law. Prior to his election to the Ontario legislature, he practised law in Bruce County, Ontario.

Mr. Elston is Chair of the Walkerton Clean Water Centre. He is also Past Chair of the Board of Directors of the University of Ottawa Institute of Mental Health Research and Energy Dialogue Group. He serves on the boards of the Canadian Centre for Energy Information, Canadian Nurses Foundation and Hydro One.
