John Froats is President & Chief Executive Officer of the CANDU Owners Group (COG). COG is a private, not for profit Company which is voluntarily funded by its Members. It provides Member Services in the areas of CANDU Nuclear Research and Development, Operating Experience, Joint Projects and Regulatory Affairs. John brings over 32 years of Nuclear Generation experience to his role in COG.

Prior to joining COG John held a number of leadership roles in Ontario Power Generation (OPG). OPG is an Ontario-based electricity generator whose principal business is the generation and sale of electricity in Ontario and to interconnected markets, while operating in a safe, open and environmentally responsible manner.

John Froats was appointed to his current position in August 2006 and is responsible for the overall leadership, management and operation of the COG business. Before joining COG, John held the position of Vice President Engineering & Modifications and Chief Nuclear Engineer for OPG for approximately 2.5 years. In this role, he was accountable for the Nuclear Engineering function in OPG and for the successful delivery of the Nuclear Project Portfolio. Prior to that, he was Director, Engineering Services and responsible for the provision of engineering specialty services and design changes to the Pickering and Darlington Nuclear Power Stations from August 2003 to February 2004.

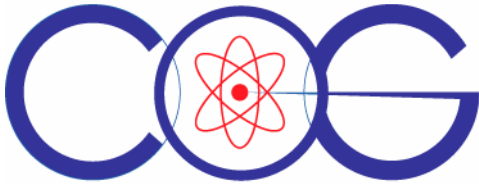
In June 2005 John was awarded with the OPG “Power Within” 2004 Achievement Award for “Leadership”.

He also held the position of Vice President, Nuclear Security Enhancements, accountable to implement Nuclear Security Program improvements in both engineered provisions and program operations to meet regulatory expectations in the wake of the Sept 2001 World Trade Centre tragedy. During this period he also served as Chair of the Canadian Inter-Utility Security Working Group to lead Nuclear Security improvement across Canada.

As Director Site Support, Pickering Nuclear Generating Station from April 1999 to April 2002, he was responsible for the provision of materials, security, business, facilities, information technology and programming services.

John Froats has held various positions at the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station, including Director Site Engineering, Engineering Services Manager, Technical Superintendent, Electrical, Instrumentation & Control and Shift Supervisor.

John Froats joined Ontario Hydro, the predecessor company of OPG, in 1974 and worked at the Bruce Heavy Water Plant until 1980 when he moved to the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station.

He has been a qualified Nuclear Emergency Response Manager, Emergency Response Technical Manager and an Environmental Spills Manager and has acted in these capacities in several situations including the preparation and oversight for the Y2K transition and the grid collapse in summer 2003. He currently is active in the Nuclear Executive Steering Committee of the Canadian Standards Association (CSA).

John Froats received his Bachelor of Engineering (Electrical) Degree from McMaster University, his Reactor Shift Manager Licence from the AECB and is a Registered Professional Engineer of Ontario.
